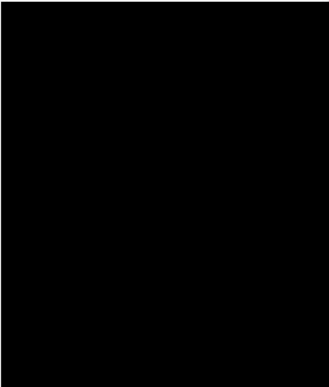

Activities and achievements

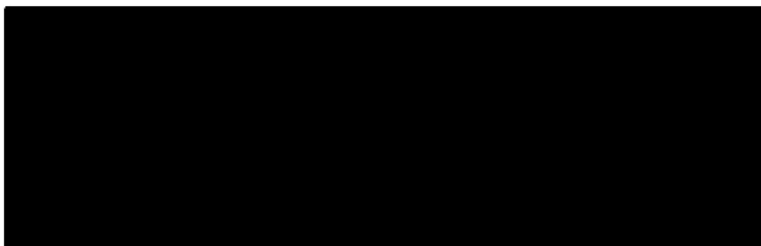
The trustees met and considered various applications and agreed and paid 32 donations to separate individual registered charities. These donations totalled £54,000. The trustees were also advised by the stockbrokers in relation to their discretionary management of the investments and considered the reports provided in this regard.

Trustee remuneration and expenses

Legal costs for administering the trust were paid to Mactaggart & Co. solicitors with which the Trustee has a business connection. [redacted] a director.

Reserves

At the end of the year Mactaggart & Co. held a balance of £42,728.02, Charles Stanley held £5,323.66 and Rathbones held £29,066.55 over and above the portfolio valuation.



Independent Examiner's Report to the Trustees of Mr & Mrs William Donald's Memorial Trust

I report on the accounts of the charity for the year ended 05 April 2025 which are set out on pages 2 to 4.

Respective responsibilities of trustees and examiner

The charity's trustees are responsible for the preparation of the accounts in accordance with the terms of the Charities and Trustee Investment (Scotland) Act 2005 and the Charities Accounts (Scotland) Regulations 2006. The charity trustees consider that the audit requirement of Regulation 10(1) (d) of the Accounts Regulations does not apply. It is my responsibility to examine the accounts as required under section 44(1) (c) of the Act and to state whether particular matters have come to my attention.

Basis of independent examiner's statement

My examination is carried out in accordance with Regulation 11 of the Charities Accounts (Scotland) Regulations 2006. An examination includes a review of the accounting records kept by the charity and a comparison of the accounts presented with those records. It also includes consideration of any unusual items or disclosures in the accounts, and seeks explanations from the trustees concerning any such matters. The procedures undertaken do not provide all the evidence that would be required in an audit, and consequently I do not express an audit opinion on the view given by the accounts.
