(4) To reduce waste, reuse resource and recycle wherever possible and promote education in the field of waste management to our community, visitors and businesses, moving towards zero waste. (5) To carry out and facilitate such projects, activities and research that conserve and protect biological diversity, natural habitats and our environment. (6) To

relieve poverty among the residents of the Isle of Islay by promoting and providing training, development and employment, particularly but not restricted to young people and residents within the community with individual needs. (7) The organisation shall have the power to do all things necessary for the fulfilment of these objectives.
