What the charity does: We are the national body for Care and Repair organisations throughout Scotland We provide services in Scotland that enable persons who are elderly, infirm, or disabled to remain in their homes by assisting with the arranging of repairs, improvements, and maintenance works. To achieve this the Charity operates a central office based in Glasgow. This office is funded entirely by grant aid from The Scottish Government.
