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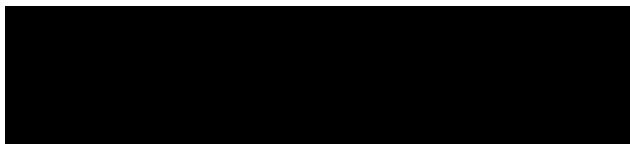
	This has helped us to keep costs to families low and avoid large fee increases at a time where the cost of living is astronomically high. The service based in St Luke's Primary School relocated, the building was no longer fit for purpose. This paved the way for an expansion, relocating to the newly built Easthouses Primary School has increased capacity by 10 children per day. Tynewater also expanded with a addition of a new room allowing again an additional 10 spaces per day. Supporting the communities that we serve and creating 2 vacancies for additional Staff members. Again this year staff retention has been high and staff have attended many training courses to develop their knowledge and understanding. We have developed our service, with a strong focus on outdoor play and supporting children's health and wellbeing through a variety of experiences, delivered by professional practitioners. Always an achievement is supporting families within our local area. Welcoming new children and providing care and support to the local community, who without us would not be able to work.
