Charitable purpose

The club's aim is to offer affordable, accessible, quality childcare in a safe and stimulating environment with experienced and trained staff running the day-to-day business. Our focus is self-directed risk assessed play and we aim to provide the opportunities for children to have fun and develop through play.

Activities and Achievements

As a service we have continued to provide a safe, nurturing, and engaging environment for children, delivering a wide range of activities that support play, learning, and wellbeing. The children have enjoyed everything from creative arts and outdoor play to themed projects and seasonal events. Children are regularly consulted to ensure that they are happy and fulfilled and their ideas and likes are reflected in the planning for daily play experiences and holiday clubs. Their feedback is continuously used to improve our planning, resource purchasing and service progression.

Our Windygoul service has continued to grow in demand and is currently full for most of the sessions. A small waitlist is in place. Sanderson's Wynd service has decreased in numbers over the last year, however this has slowly started to build due to advertising within the school.

We have a staff team who are experienced, fully qualified and registered with Scottish Social Services Council, where required to do so. All staff are committed to working on their continuous professional development to enhance and improve their knowledge and skills to meet SSSC registration requirements.

A small number of parents/carers form our Committee and show their support and commitment by attending the bi-monthly termtime meetings. They help us to make important decisions and this ultimately moulds the future direction of our service.

We will always welcome any parent who wishes to join the Committee and support us. Thank you so much for any support you give us in whatever capacity.

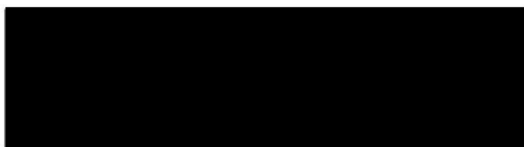
Independent Examiner's Statement
