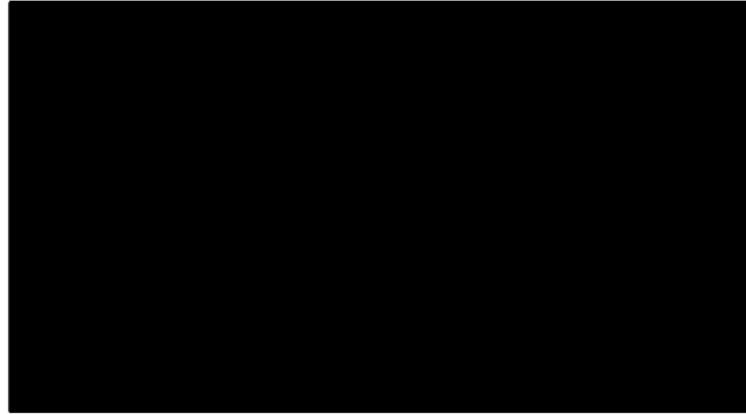

TRUSTEE REPORT YEAR ENDING 31.12.2024



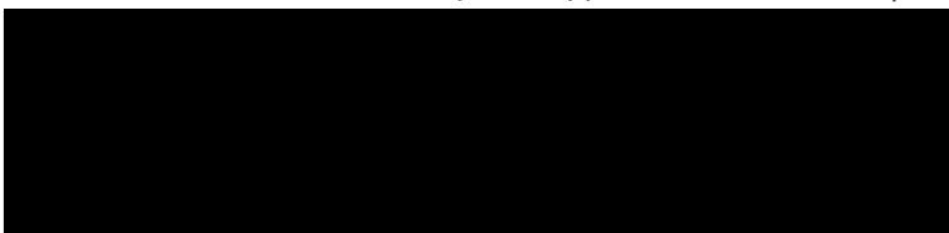
Structure, Governance, Managements – Appointments made by church ballot as per details in church constitution.

Achievements and performance – Over the last year we have been able to open more opportunities to people in the community including running daytime events during school holidays. We are involving more youth in our outreach work. Working within the local communities with various assistance to them which is now including a food pantry which we open two days a week. We have also been given a grant from FIEC to help with this as we weekly buy extra supplies for those who use the food pantry.

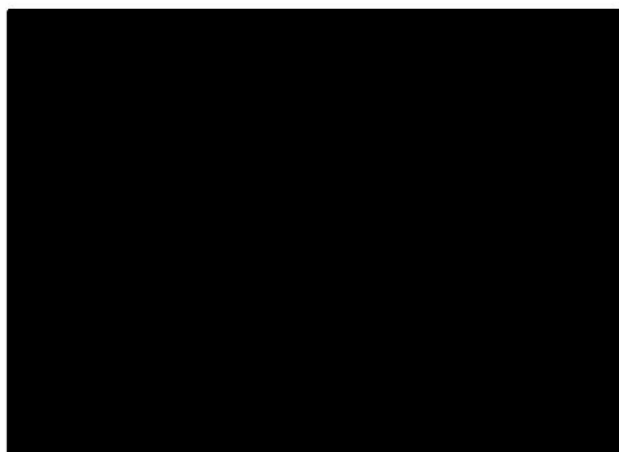
