Respective responsibilities of trustees and examiner

Basis of independent examiner's statement

Achievements and performance

Summary of the main achievements of the charity during the financial period

Term time demand for the before and after school clubs at our Troon base is generally excellent though uptake for our holiday clubs varies, particularly during the shorter breaks. In August 2024 we were delighted to open an after school club at Barassie Primary School. This had previously been the only Primary school in the area without access to this provision. Imaginative, active and outdoor active remain a key focus and the wide varieties of activities provided continues to be positively received by the children.

Financial review

Brief statement of the charity's policy on reserves

Our reserves policy is that surplus funds are reinvested in the club, and our fee structure remains under review to ensure affordability for parents.

Details of any deficit

2024/25 was a difficult operating year financially during which the club operated at a loss of -£14,982.36. This was partially anticipated following our decision not to wholly pass on operating cost increases and restrict fee increases to parents from August 2024 but compounded by take up at Barassie being much lower than indicated as well as the costs associated by a long-term sickness absence. Fees were increased again in August 2025 and uptake at Barassie from August 2025 is now covering day to day costs, We continue to carefully monitor finances and are looking at ways to secure additional funding.

Committee members perform the following to keep operating costs as low as possible to ensure fees are affordable for parents: -
Payroll, Book-keeping and preparing accounts.



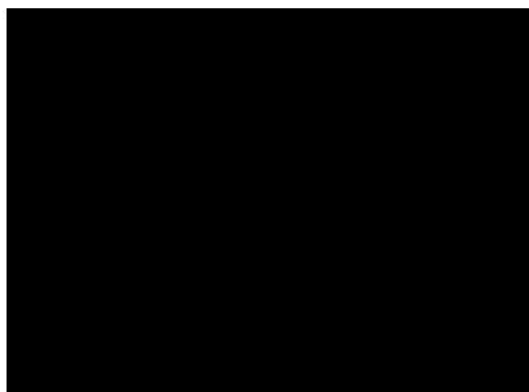

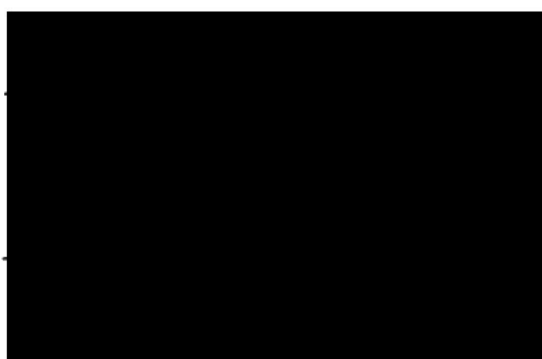
