With the help of a Creative Learning Officer, the charity receives commissions to plan and carry out workshops and education programmes in schools. Much of our work springs directly from the Highlands' defining characteristics: a stunningly beautiful and harsh natural landscape. a tumultuous and marginalised history. a shifting and changing population. a vibrant oral and musical tradition.
