

### Achievements and performance

We have supported many children from Campbeltown and the surrounding rural areas and continue to see our membership increase year on year. During 2024 we continued to have over 300 children attending the weekly sessions.

### Financial Review

Reserves within the charity are maintained as retained profit, to be used to mitigate any shortfall in funding in subsequent years. The club is confident it has enough reserves to cover its liabilities.

### Donations and Grants

Campbeltown District Juvenile Football Association received several donations and grants throughout 2024, totalling £11,880 (2023 - £22,061).


### Fundraising

A great deal of fundraising is undertaken each year. A total of £3,710 was raised in 2024 (2023 - £2,476).

# Independent Examiner's Report

## Campbeltown District Juvenile Football Association For the year ended 31 December 2024

I report on the accounts of Campbeltown District Juvenile Football Association for the year ended 31 December 2024 which are set out herewith.

### **Respective responsibilities of Trustees and Examiner**

The charity's trustees are responsible for the preparation of the accounts in accordance with the terms of the Charities and Trustee Investment (Scotland) Act 2005 and the Charities Account (Scotland) Regulations 2006. The charity trustees consider that the audit requirement of Regulation 10(1) (a) t (c) of the Accounts Regulations does not apply. It is my responsibility to examine the accounts as required under section 44(1) (c) of the Act and to state whether particular matters have come to my attention.

### **Basis of Independent Examiners Statement**

My examination was carried out in accordance with Regulation 11 of the Charities Accounts (Scotland) Regulations 2006. An examination includes a review of the accounting records kept by the charity and a comparison of the accounts presented with those records. It also includes consideration of any unusual items or disclosures in the accounts and seeks explanations from the trustees concerning any such matters. The procedures undertaken do not provide all the evidence that would be required in an audit and, consequently, I do not express an audit opinion on the view given by these accounts.
