Objectives: a) to promote the benefit of the inhabitants of the Croftamie Community Council area - the 'Operating Area' - without distinction of sex, sexuality, political, religious or other opinions by associating the local statutory authorities, voluntary organisations and inhabitants in a common effort to advance education and to provide facilities, or assist in the provision of facilities, in the interest of social welfare for recreation and other leisure time occupation so that their conditions of life may be improved. b) to preserve, restore and improve the environment in and around the Operating Area through the provision, maintenance and/or improvement of public open space and other public amenities and other environmental and townscape regeneration projects, and in doing so, to seek wherever appropriate (but subject to appropriate safeguards to ensure that the public benefit so arising clearly outweighs any private benefit thereby conferred on private landowners) to carry out works of reclamation, remediation, restoration and other operations to facilitate the use for those purposes of land whose use has been prevented or restricted because of previous use. c) to assist in the provision of housing for people in necessitous circumstances within the Operating Area. d) to promote trade and 'industry for the benefit of the general public. e) to promote, establish and operate other

schemes of a charitable nature for the benefit of the community within the Operating Area.
