Charitable purpose: To provide a car share scheme and transport for the elderly and vulnerable in the speyside area.

Sourcing drivers willing to drive others and making arrangements to meet the needs of the clients.

ACHIEVEMENTS AND PERFORMANCE

Charitable activities

The charity's main sources of income came from Moray Car Share, Berryburn Community Fund, The Cora Foundation, The Corra Foundation, The National Lottery & Rothes Wind Farm. Also generously supported through donations from individuals, groups and businesses in the local community. A successful fundraising raffle was held for the 20th anniversary of the Scheme.

FINANCIAL REVIEW

Reserves policy

The Committee considers that the general fund will again be reused to enable the charity to run. There is a high level of expenses and wages to be paid out each month before any income is received. The committee is also aware that grants may not always be available.

Our association is a charitable unincorporated, one the purpose and administration arrangements are set out in our constitution.

Recruitment and appointment of new trustees

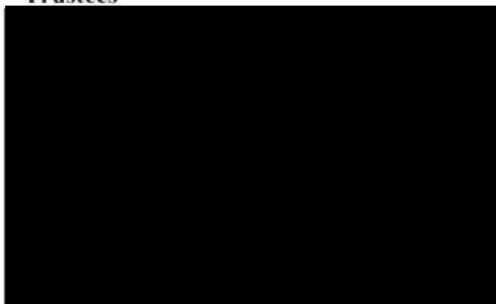

1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Basis of preparing the financial statements

The financial statements of the charity, which is a public benefit entity under FRS 102, have been prepared in accordance with the Charities SORP (FRS 102) 'Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective 1 January 2019)', Financial Reporting Standard 102 'The Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland' and the Charities Act 2011. The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention.

Income

All income is recognised in the Statement of Financial Activities once the charity has entitlement to the funds, it is probable that the income will be received and the amount can be measured reliably.

Expenditure

Liabilities are recognised as expenditure as soon as there is a legal or constructive obligation committing the charity to that expenditure, it is probable that a transfer of economic benefits will be required in settlement and the amount of the obligation can be measured reliably. Expenditure is accounted for on an accruals basis and has been classified under headings that aggregate all cost related to the category. Where costs cannot be directly attributed to particular headings they have been allocated to activities on a basis consistent with the use of resources.

Tangible fixed assets

Depreciation is provided at the following annual rates in order to write off each asset over its estimated useful life.

Plant and machinery	- 20% on reducing balance
Computer equipment	- 33% on cost

Taxation

The charity is exempt from tax on its charitable activities.

Fund accounting

Unrestricted funds can be used in accordance with the charitable objectives at the discretion of the trustees.

Restricted funds can only be used for particular restricted purposes within the objects of the charity. Restrictions arise when specified by the donor or when funds are raised for particular restricted purposes.

Further explanation of the nature and purpose of each fund is included in the notes to the financial statements.
