#### Summary of the main achievements of the charity during the financial period

The money raised by the parent council throughout the year, along with grant income received allowed them to support the school in many ways.

Main achievements this year include:

- Running the kitchen and Santa's Grotto at the school Christmas fayre
- Goody bags for "Festive Friday" day in school
- Easter eggs for all pupils
- Purchase of benches and bins for school playground
- Paying for school buses to allow the pupils to have end of year school trips
- Purchase of bears for new P1s

- Providing all pupils and staff with an ice cream on the last day of school
