What the charity does: At the Social Enterprise Academy, we believe social entrepreneurs play an essential role in changing the world. (e) To liaise with European, UK, Scottish and local government authorities and agencies, further or higher education establishments, local enterprise companies, local economic development companies, voluntary sector bodies and others, all with a view to maximising the effectiveness of the company in pursuing its objectives.
