Objectives: The company's objects are specifically restricted to the following charitable purposes:- 1. The company has been formed to advance the education, promote the health and welfare and to relieve the poverty of Chinese people in the Highlands & Islands and Moray and in furtherance thereof but not otherwise the company shall seek i) to facilitate, co-ordinate and organise activities in the area to promote Chinese culture, and to enable Chinese people to integrate into the wider community, ii) to encourage wider community involvement with the Chinese population, iii) to reflect the opinions of the Chinese population in

the area, and act as their voice, iv)to provide information, consultation and support for all members, and specifically to offer an interpretation service to facilitate individual's communication with official bodies, and v) to assist individuals in need to access help so as to alleviate their hardship. 2. Such other similar charitable purposes as the company from time to time determines
