Lyra challenges the inequity of quality performing arts provision for children and teenagers, regardless of their ability to pay. We overcome socio-economic disadvantage by empowering children and teenagers to access their cultural rights, engaging them in the arts as co-curators and collaborators. Our aim is to reach every child and teenager in Greater Craigmillar, and our vision is that they will one day lead Lyra in the future.
