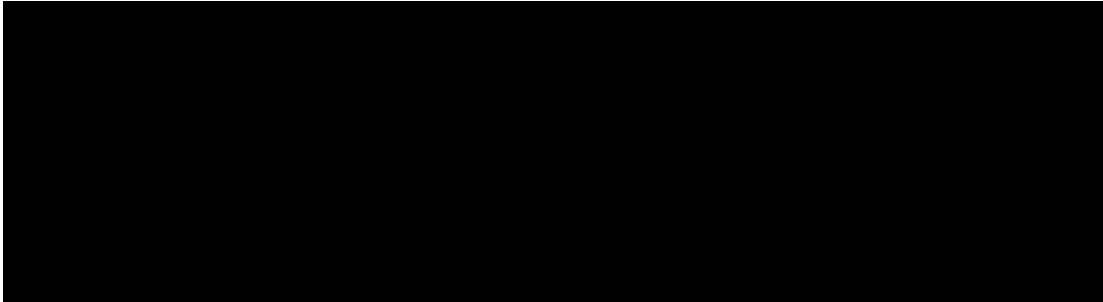

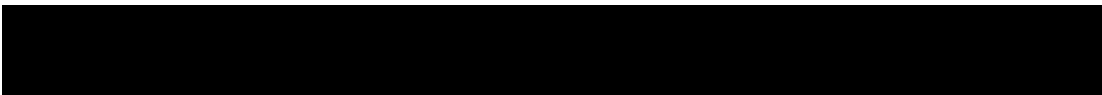

We continue to work hard for our organisation to gain new members both young and old.

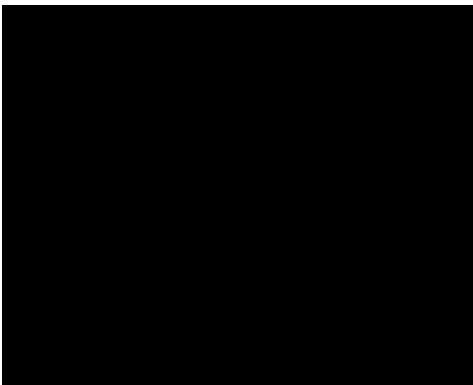

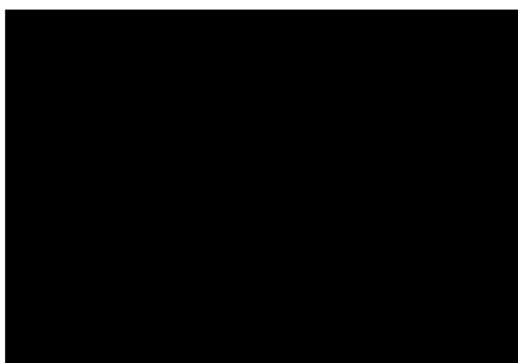
