Activities

Activities: 'It carries out activities or services itself'

Purposes: 'the prevention or relief of poverty', 'the advancement of health', 'the advancement of citizenship or community development', 'the advancement of the arts, heritage, culture or science', 'the provision of recreational facilities, or the organisation of recreational activities, with the object of improving the conditions of life for the persons for whom the facilities or activities are primarily intended', 'the relief of those in need by reason of age, ill-health, disability, financial hardship or other disadvantage', 'any other purpose that may reasonably be regarded as analogous to any of the preceding purposes'

What the charity does: The company's objects and principal activities are to address the issues associated with youth in the council wards of West Glasgow. Since COVID 19, we have worked in partnership with Glasgow City Council to work with local community groups and schools to help improve their environment and educate young people on the impact they can have on their world.

Beneficiaries: 'Children or young people'

Objectives: (1) To provide in the interests of social welfare within the council ward of West Glasgow ('the operating area') (but with a primary focus on the Partick community in Glasgow, which shall apply to each reference in this clause to the operating area) facilities for recreation and other leisure time occupation of the young people with the objective of improving their conditions of life. (2) To advance education through the promotion of the arts, particularly among young people resident in the operating area. (3) To relieve poverty, primarily among young people resident in the operating area. (4) To provide or promote training to young people, particularly in such skills as will assist the participants in obtaining paid employment. (5) To promote and protect the wellbeing and physical health of young people resident in the operating area, and to assist in the relief of ill health and the provision of health education for such residents. (6) To relieve the needs of young people (and particularly those resident in the operating area) who suffer from mental and/or physical disability, illness or impairment or have particular needs by reason of current or past drug, solvent and/or alcohol abuse, and their carers and families. (7) To preserve, for the benefit of young people, the historical,

architectural and constructional heritage that may exist in or around the operating area, in buildings (including any structure or erection, and any part of a building as so defined) of particular beauty or historical, architectural and constructional interest. (8) To promote, establish, operate and/or support any other charitable projects or initiatives for the benefit of the community within the operating area.
