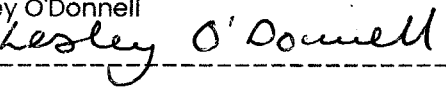

The unit received donations in kind of Easter Eggs, sweets for parties, paper, card and stationery supplies.
