Activities: 'It carries out activities or services itself'

Purposes: 'the advancement of citizenship or community development', 'the advancement of the arts, heritage, culture or science', 'the advancement of environmental protection or improvement'

What the charity does: Development Coll is set up to assist in the sustainable development of the island and it's community. It currently operates a community center that is open year round and staffed by 2 full time equivalent employee's. An Cridhe(the community center) provides a space for community groups and individuals to meet. sports facilities and events. The organisation also operates a mobile phone mast providing cover to the island. Since August 2025 we have also employed a Community Development Officer with funds secured through the Strengthening Communities Partnership administered by DTAS.

(viii) the preservation of buildings or sites of historic or architectural importance. the provision or assistance in the provision of recreational facilities for the public at large and/or those who, by reasons of their youth, age, infirmity or disablement, poverty or social and economic circumstances, have need of such facilities. the protection or conservation of the environment.
