The Trustees all live within different areas within the main area of benefit of the fund which brings varied expertise along with expert local knowledge.

Objectives: 3.1 The object for which the Company has been established is to advance the development of the community and in particular to promote rural regeneration of the area around the wind farm at Foudland ('Windfarm') by providing, from contributions received from third parties including Glens of Foudland Wind Farm Limited ('Windco'), benefits for the welfare of residents and visitors to that area. These benefits will include the provision of or procuring the provision of and management and maintenance of social, recreational, health, educational, cultural and environmental facilities.
