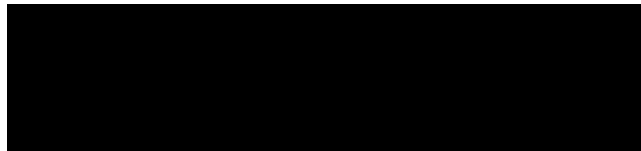
Membership and management

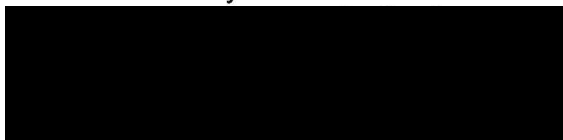

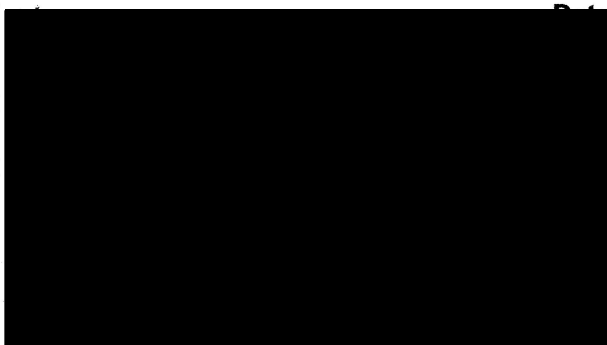
