housing for people in necessitous circumstances (viii) To provide, in the interests of social welfare, facilities for recreation and other leisure time activities available to the public at large within the Operating Area (ix) To encourage, stimulate and support volunteering principally in the Operating Area To preserve, restore and improve the environment in the Operating Area through the provision, maintenance and/or improvement of public open space and other public amenities and other environmental and townscape regeneration projects (but subject to appropriate safeguards to ensure that the public benefits so arising clearly outweigh any private benefit thereby conferred on private landowners) (xi) To promote, establish, operate and/or support other projects and initiatives of a
