land, and associated assets for the benefit of the community and the public generally. and (ii) the advancement of community development, including regeneration. and (iii) the advancement of education about the environment, science and sustainable development generally and about the heritage, arts and culture of different communities specifically. and (iv) the provision, or assisting in the provision, of recreational facilities, and/or organisation of recreational activities, which will be available to the local community and the public generally.
