Our activities include: • Repackaging vital information into formats that can be used by target groups • Organizing seminars, workshops, talks and meetings aimed at solving community problems • Organizing employability skills training including literacy and ICT skills training • Providing reading material, including newspapers, materials on formal education, income generation, adult literacy and entertainment. • Promoting appropriate technologies • Documentation of local events • Organizing recreational activities such as games and cultural activities
