**What the charity does:** Ionad Thròndairnis Trust's primary objective is to raise and/or secure funds/funding to assist in the fulfilment of the plans to establish a cultural hub encompassing the wider Trotternish Peninsula. The principal function of the facility will be to provide a place whereby the songs, stories, Gàidhlig language - spoken and recorded - cultural and environmental history will be retained to enhance visitor experiences. Opportunities will be offered to expand and enhance the experiences of all users and visitors to Ionad Thròndairnis with an awareness of the language and heritage, throughout the building. Community mapping, preservation of artefacts and archived resources will be developed and made available both in person and digitally through the Trust's 'Guthan na Tìre/Voices of the Land' programme.
