Report of the Trustees
for the Year Ended 31st December 2023

The trustees present their report with the financial statements of the charity for the year ended 31st December 2023. The trustees have adopted the provisions of Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective 1 January 2019).

OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES

Objectives and aims

The Church's main purpose is 'to promote SNU Spiritualism, defined as the religion and religious philosophy of Spiritualism, which recognises the Fatherhood of God, the Brotherhood of Man, the Communion of Spirits and the Ministry of Angels, the Continuous Existence of the Human Soul, Personal Responsibility, Compensation and Retribution Hereafter for all the Good and Evil Deeds done on Earth and Eternal Progress open to every Human Soul.'

Volunteers

The Church relies on the general committee to volunteer their time to help prepare for and run the Services.

ACHIEVEMENT AND PERFORMANCE

Charitable activities

The year has seen the church continuing its fortnightly services however there has been a significant decrease in people attending, with an average of 30-35 people per service compared with the previous year of 45 people per service. The committee are aware of this for the coming year and are making efforts to try and increase the footfall with the introduction of new mediums who have varying ways of presenting spiritualism. During the year to 31st December 2023 2 laptops were purchased, one for the treasurer and one for the secretary. This is to warrant our compliance with General Data Protection ensuring that the Church data is held on the equipment belonging to the Church and not on personal computers. The Church portrays that its services are open all and that everyone attending the Church will be made welcome. The public and members of the Church are updated with events through Facebook and other avenues.

FINANCIAL REVIEW

Reserves policy

As a result of the deficit for the year of £1,643 (2022 Deficit £938), the Church held unrestricted funds of £78,978 (2022: £80,621) at the year end.

We aim to maintain reserves at a level which is at least equivalent to £8,000 which would enable us to cover annual expenses for a year and any one off expenses in the event of any unforeseen circumstances.

STRUCTURE, GOVERNANCE AND MANAGEMENT

Governing document

The Church is an unincorporated trust, constituted under the Rules of the Spiritualist's National Union and is a registered Scottish charity, number SC041289.

Recruitment and appointment of new trustees

In accordance with the terms of the SNU Rule Book there must be a minimum of six trustees, with further increases in numbers as the church members see fit. New trustees are appointed by a majority vote of existing members. Trustees retire from post by giving notice in writing.

Risk management

The trustees have a duty to identify and review the risks to which the charity is exposed and to ensure appropriate controls are in place to provide reasonable assurance against fraud and error.

Independent Examiner's Report to the Trustees of
Dumfries Spiritualist Church

I report on the accounts for the year ended 31st December 2023 set out on pages four to nine.

Respective responsibilities of trustees and examiner

The charity's trustees are responsible for the preparation of the accounts in accordance with the terms of the Charities and Trustee Investment (Scotland) Act 2005 and the Charities Accounts (Scotland) Regulations 2006 (as amended). The charity's trustees consider that the audit requirement of Regulation 10(1)(a) to (c) of the Accounts Regulations does not apply. It is my responsibility to examine the accounts as required under Section 44(1)(c) of the Act and to state whether particular matters have come to my attention.

Basis of the independent examiner's report

My examination was carried out in accordance with Regulation 11 of the Charities Accounts (Scotland) Regulations 2006. An examination includes a review of the accounting records kept by the charity and a comparison of the accounts presented with those records. It also includes consideration of any unusual items or disclosures in the accounts, and seeking explanations from you as trustees concerning any such matters. The procedures undertaken do not provide all the evidence that would be required in an audit, and consequently I do not express an audit opinion on the view given by the accounts.

1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Basis of preparing the financial statements

The financial statements of the charity, which is a public benefit entity under FRS 102, have been prepared in accordance with the Charities SORP (FRS 102) 'Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective 1 January 2019)', Financial Reporting Standard 102 'The Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland' and the Charities and Trustee Investment (Scotland) Act 2005. The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention.

Income

All income is recognised in the Statement of Financial Activities once the charity has entitlement to the funds, it is probable that the income will be received and the amount can be measured reliably.

Expenditure

Liabilities are recognised as expenditure as soon as there is a legal or constructive obligation committing the charity to that expenditure, it is probable that a transfer of economic benefits will be required in settlement and the amount of the obligation can be measured reliably. Expenditure is accounted for on an accruals basis and has been classified under headings that aggregate all cost related to the category. Where costs cannot be directly attributed to particular headings they have been allocated to activities on a basis consistent with the use of resources.

Taxation

The charity is exempt from tax on its charitable activities.

Fund accounting

Unrestricted funds can be used in accordance with the charitable objectives at the discretion of the trustees.

Restricted funds can only be used for particular restricted purposes within the objects of the charity. Restrictions arise when specified by the donor or when funds are raised for particular restricted purposes.

Further explanation of the nature and purpose of each fund is included in the notes to the financial statements.
