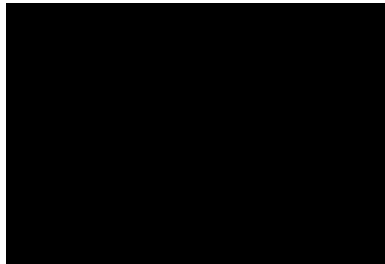

## **TRUST RUGBY INTERNATIONAL**

### **REPORT OF THE TRUSTEES**

The Trustees present their report and annual accounts for the year ended 31 March 2024

#### **OBJECTIVES:**

Trust Rugby International (TRI) was formed in March 2010 with the purposes of "the advancement of public participation in sport" and "the promotion of equality and diversity".

TRI later became a charitable organisation in 2013, with the objective of "Bringing individuals, communities and cultures together through Rugby" Latterly TRI became a SCIO in 2017.

The vision of achieving social inclusion for everyone spans from building social confidence for those with little experience of navigating life to supporting rehabilitation of those wishing to re-enter their community.

TRI have pioneered 'unified' rugby in Scotland as a means to build confidence and social skills. Gathering individuals from different backgrounds and communities, with and without intellectual disabilities, as well as varying degrees of experience, TRI want to enable everyone to live life to the fullest.

The organisations mission is "Creating projects that target personal development and social integration by developing strategic partnerships"

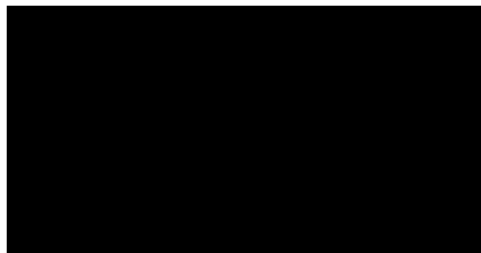
The foregoing charitable purposes being principally furthered through (1) the creation of "unified rugby teams" within established rugby clubs (2) the development of suitable training and safeguarding guidelines to enable training sessions and build confidence in coaches and players (3) forming key partnerships with health and social organisations to enable a pathway for players. TRI are now an affiliated club to the Scottish Rugby Union (SRU) (4) the provision of assistance (whether financial or otherwise) to other charities and organisations that have similar purposes and objectives to TRI.

The Trustees declare that in exercising these purposes they shall have proper regard to the spirit of the original constitution and intend the exercise of (3) and (4) above to empower the Trustees to further the purposes in a circumstance where the purposes of the charity will be furthered.

#### **MANAGEMENT:**

The charity is managed by the Trustees listed above.

Accounts for the year show a surplus of £38,423. The Trustees are of the opinion that the restructuring of 22/23 creating smaller charities within clubs has been a positive step ensuring the continuation of unified rugby within the original rugby clubs.
