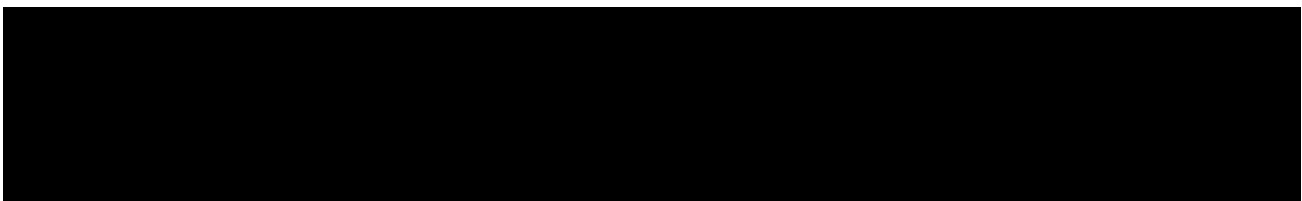

Activities & Achievements

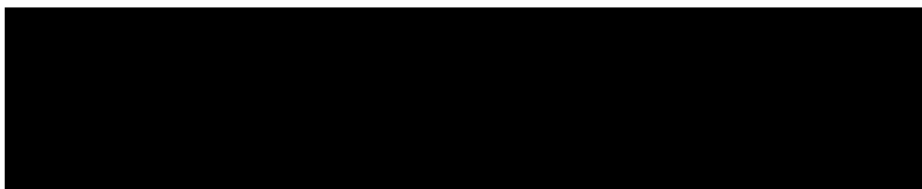
During the year, the Group has continued its usual range of activities including weekly section camps and outings for all of the sections.

I report on the financial statements of the 1st Biggar/Tinto Scout Group for the year ended 31st March 2025

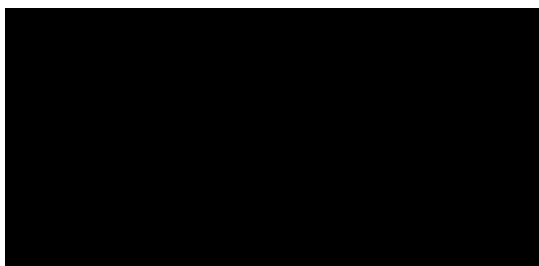
Basis of Independent Examiner's Statement

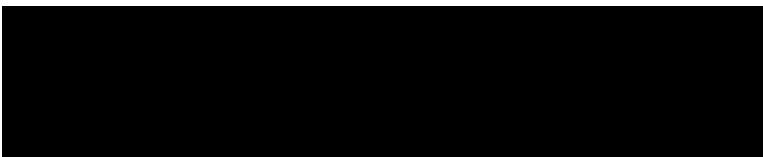
