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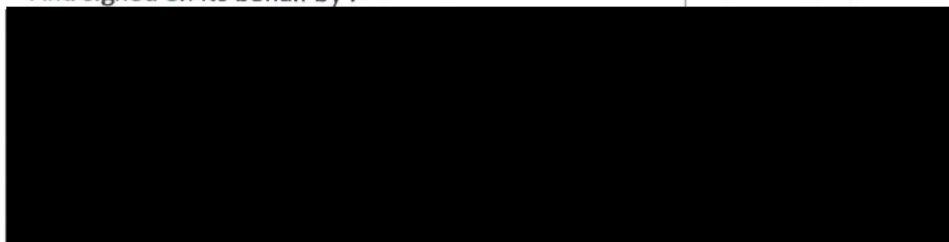

**Independent Examiner's Report to the Trustees of the 1st Midlothian Scout Group**

I report on the financial statements of the 1st Midlothian Scout Group ("the Group") for the year ended 31st March 2025 which are set out on following pages.

**Respective responsibilities of Trustees and Examiner**

The Group's Trustees are responsible for the preparation of the accounts in accordance with the Charities and Trustee Investment (Scotland) Act 2005 ("the Act") and the Charities Accounts (Scotland) Regulations 2006 ("the Regulations"). The Group's Trustees consider that the audit requirement of Regulation 10(1)(d) does not apply. It is my responsibility to examine the accounts as required under section 44(1)© of the Act and to state whether particular matters have come to my attention.

**Basis of independent Examiner's Statement**

My examination is carried out in accordance with the Regulations. An examination includes a review of the accounting records kept by the Group and a comparison of the accounts presented with those records. It also includes consideration of any unusual items or disclosures in the accounts and seeks explanations from the Trustees concerning any such matters. The procedures undertaken do not provide all the evidence that would be required in an audit, and consequently I do not express an audit opinion on the view given by the accounts.

**Independent Examiner's statement**

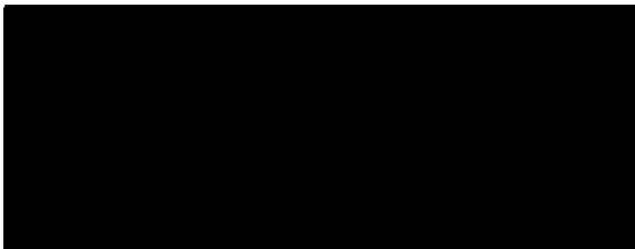
In connection with my examination, no matter has come to my attention:-

(a) to keep accounting records in accordance with the Regulations,  
and

(b) to prepare accounts which agree with the accounting records and comply with the Regulations have not been met, or

(2) to which, in my opinion, attention should be drawn in order to enable a proper understanding of the accounts to be reached

2024 Accounts (restated)

"2024 figures restated to reflect adjustments as follows;

- (a) Grouping all received income from membership subscriptions into single item, rather than splitting across Group Income, Subscriptions & Capitation
- (b) £4,248.75 Grant Income (Gift Aid 22/23 tax year) mistakenly reported in FY24 which was actually received in FY25
- (c) Capitation paid to HQ overstated by £224.00 - additional amount paid in FY25
- (d) Scout expenditure understated by £55.14 - credit used in FY25
