Objectives: The charity trustees shall use the income and capital of the organisation for any purposes as are charitable and for the public benefit , with particular emphasis on advancing the standard of healthcare for children suffering from cancer, and providing practical and emotional support to children and their families during a paediatric cancer diagnosis and subsequent care. The charity trustees may, instead of themselves paying or applying any of the income or capital, pay or transfer the same to any other trusts, organisations, societies, institutions, corporations, associations, and other bodies meeting these purposes. The income or capital paid or transferred may be used either for their general purposes or for any specific purpose as the charity trustees may decide. In exercising their discretion in terms of this Clause the charity trustees shall be entitled to give consideration to the wishes of those persons who gift or lend funds to the organisation, but shall primarily seek to support organisations that supported Emma Cameron whom the Foundation is named after.

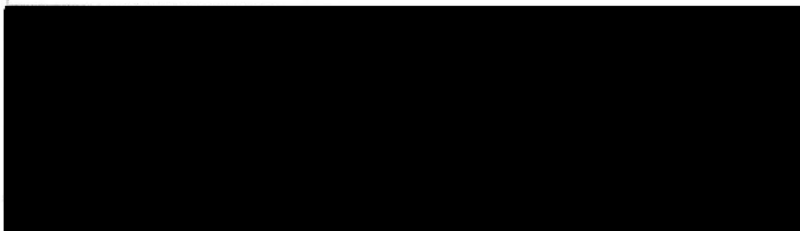

Achievements and performance

Summary of the main achievements of the charity during the financial period

Our income was in line with our forecast at £52744 against an expenditure of £65313 creating a deficit in 24/25 but maintaining an overall acceptable balance in the Charity. We were able to provide the level of grants we did thanks to the additional surplus we raised in 2023/24 .

The Foundation continued to support our key partners, that helped Emma during her illness, which is the main aim of the Foundation.

Financial review

Brief statement of the charity's policy on reserves

End of year balance is £18900. This reflects the level of balance the Trustees have agreed is appropriate for the charity to hold. We anticipate a similar schedule of events in 25/26 as 24/25 thus hopefully meaning we are able to maintain giving levels broadly in line with previous years without affecting our Reserves. Event Costs are anticipated to increase which may affect event attendance and income raised.

Details of any deficit

A deficit of £12569 was accumulated in 24/25 reflecting additional distribution of funds raised at the latter stages of the previous year after payment of main grants.

Donated facilities and services (if any)

Legal and IT support has been provided to the Foundation by our supporters without cost. Independent Examiner support is provided without cost. Event management is undertaken by volunteers without cost.

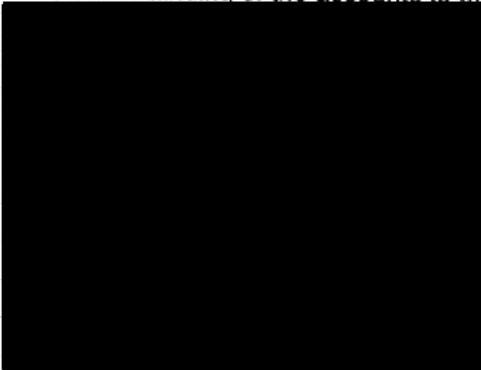
