Capacity and skills building programme for local community groups and charities. Community resilience service addressing the issues of food and fuel poverty, providing information, advice, training, signposting, referrals to other services and volunteering opportunities.

To advance in life and help young people through providing support and activities which develop their skills, capacities and capabilities to enable them to participate in society as mature and responsible individuals. 5. The prevention or relief of poverty in the Merkinch area of Inverness by providing services to individuals in need. 6. To develop the capacity and skills

of the members of the socially and economically disadvantaged community of Merkinch in such a way that they are better able to identify, and help meet, their needs.
