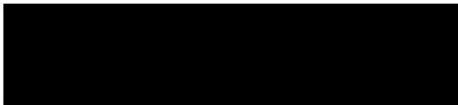

Introduction

Friends For All Project is a small Scottish Charity (SC042888), and operating in Glasgow. We seek to support to empower young offenders with the object of improving the conditions of life for the persons for whom the facilities or activities are primarily intended.

Aims/Objectives

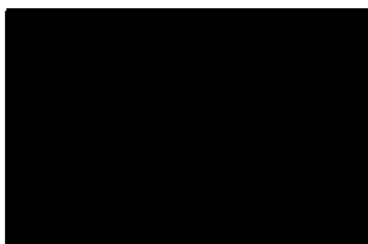
- Select suitable accounting policies and then apply them consistently.

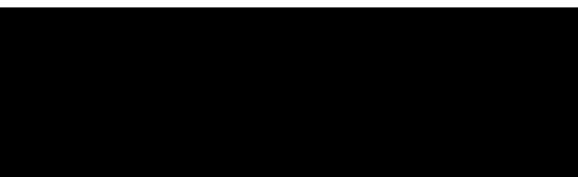
Basis of independent examiner's statement

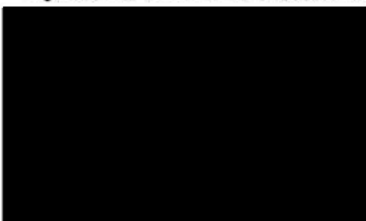
