Constitution

The charity is a Scottish Charitable Incorporated Organisation (a SCIO). The charity was awarded charitable status on 30th January 2012. It is governed by its constitution and trustees are appointed in accordance with the Constitution.

Objectives and Activities

Charitable purposes

The purposes of the charity are:

To provide facilities, and assist in the provision of activities, in the interest of social welfare for recreation and other leisure time occupation so that the conditions of life for local residents and visitors may be improved, and;

To advance citizenship and community development by promoting social interaction and community cohesion within the village and its immediate surrounds.

Achievements and Performance

The trustees are pleased to have been able to reduce their deficit for the year to £230 compared to £1,225 in 2024.

Hall hires continue to generate income and the committee continue to look at ways to reduce rising running costs and to promote hall usage.

Trustees' Annual Report continued

Achievements and Performance continued

The committee was delighted to be able to host the annual Christmas meal for the villagers over 70 again this year. The hall trustees provide the venue and volunteers prepare and serve the food. The event is fully funded by contributions and collaborations with the school and other organisations within the village.

Sadly our soup lunches had to be stopped in March 2025 due to other commitments of the volunteer that run the event. The committee have so far been unsuccessful in finding a replacement.

A successful bingo evening was held as a fundraiser during the year and was very much enjoyed by all those who attended. The committee are looking forward to planning more events in 2026.

Risk management

The trustees have assessed the major risks to which the charity is exposed, in particular those related to the operations and finance of the charity and are satisfied that systems are in place to mitigate exposure to the risks. Procedures are in place to comply with health and safety of staff, volunteers and visitors as this is felt to be a significant risk area.

Financial review

During the year funds totalling £5,534 have been generated on the general fund through fundraising activities, donations, hall hires and income from solar panels.


General running costs and expenses on the general fund totalled £5,764 in the year leaving a deficit at the year end of £230.

Reserves policy

The balance on the unrestricted general fund reserve at 31st August 2025 was £10,882. With hall hires remaining popular and continuing opportunities to promote the venue, the trustees consider this balance to be appropriate to allow them to meet their charitable objectives in the future.

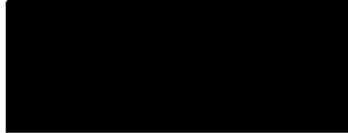

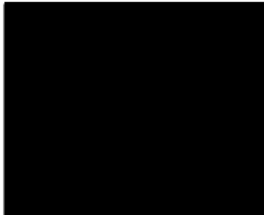

There was an unexpected replacement cloth that had to be purchased for the snooker table. This had been due to accidental damage. In addition to this two planned fundraising activities had to be cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances.

During the year funds totalling £4,806 have been generated on the general fund through fundraising activities, donations, hall hires and income from solar panels.

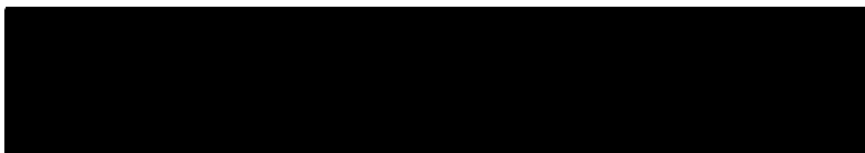
