Aid 4 All has raised £22,635 from donations in this financial period. Some of this money (and some of last year's money raised) has been used to supply essential aid to Syrian refugees caught up in the Syrian conflict. In particular to help refugees in camps in Northern Syria through food aid and help with the camps accommodation.
