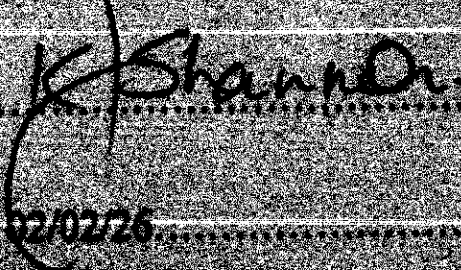

1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Basis of preparing the financial statements

The financial statements of the charity, which is a public benefit entity under FRS 102, have been prepared in accordance with the Charities SORP (FRS 102) 'Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective 1 January 2019) ¹, Financial Reporting Standard 102 'The Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland' and the Charities Act 2011. The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention.

Income

All income is recognised in the Statement of Financial Activities once the charity has received the funds.

Expenditure

Liabilities are recognised as expenditure as soon as there is a legal or constructive obligation committing the charity to that expenditure, it is probable that a transfer of economic benefits will be required in settlement and the amount of the obligation can be measured reliably. Expenditure is accounted for on a cash basis and has been classified under headings that aggregate all cost related to the category. Where costs cannot be directly attributed to particular headings they have been allocated to activities on a basis consistent with the use of resources.

Tangible fixed assets

Depreciation is provided at the following annual rates in order to write off each asset over its estimated useful life.

Computer equipment - 15% on reducing balance. Phones – 30% on reducing balance

Taxation

The charity is exempt from tax on its charitable activities.

Fund accounting

Unrestricted funds can be used in accordance with the charitable objectives at the discretion of the trustees.

Restricted funds can only be used for particular restricted purposes within the objects of the charity. Restrictions arise when specified by the donor or when funds are raised for particular restricted purposes.

The trustees have adopted the provisions of Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective 1 January 2019).

OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES

Objectives and aims

The network's main objective is to work together to promote better outcomes for people in receipt of Self-Directed Support (SDS) or who are interested in pursuing this means to enable independent living, improve quality of life, and facilitate active participation in and full integration into society.

ACHIEVEMENT AND PERFORMANCE

Charitable activities

We continue to operate with a small number of Board Members, we would encourage members to join or Board Meetings which are on Zoom and consider joining the Board.

The Board meets every six weeks via Zoom.

We have kept a tight rein on expenditure and are fortunate that all our Board Members are volunteers and take no remuneration. For the first time in many years, we now have a full complement of Boards members.

We have applied for funding from the National Lottery & The Robertson Trust to enable the Network to employ an Outreach Worker to help members with the challenges currently being experienced with Self Directed Support.

The Network continues to directly assist people who are in dispute on various issues with South Lanarkshire Council about Self Directed Support (SDS) budgets and process. As well as providing advice we have been directly supporting members who have been in dispute with South Lanarkshire Council about budget reviews, budget reductions, utilisation of budgets and contributions towards budgets. The cases we have dealt with have been time consuming and brought into sharp focus the need to get the funding to continue to help our members.

One of the many challenges has been the length of time social services take to provide information about budgets and clarity about how budgets can be spent. This is particularly true with Carers Budgets where there is no consistency of approach with contradictory information being provided to carers.

There is the continuing issue that supported people and carers are not always being provided with the correct documentation on the completion of the SDS assessment.

We are continually emphasising the three pillars of SDS, flexibility, choice, and control.

We submitted a Freedom of Information Request (FOI) to the Scottish Government last year about charging/contributions. It is the Governments policy to abolish charges, and further FOI was submitted to get the up to date position, in a nutshell it is still in consultation stage and full details can be found on our website. We will continue to pursue this issue.

FINANCIAL REVIEW

Financial position

The Statement of Financial Activities shows net loss for the period of £3959, 2023 £2412 and our reserves stand at £8,013, 2023 £11,972.
