What the charity does: The Air Training Corps exists for the benefit of young people between the ages of 13 and 20 to provide education in aviation subjects, adventure training, sport, flying and gliding. We provide education in aviation subjects including basic navigation, principles of flight, airmanship, air navigation, propulsion, airframes, operational flying, satellite communications, aircraft handling, radio and radar. Also, citizenship training, adventure training, Duke of Edinburgh Award Scheme, sport and First Aid training. We achieve this by have one or two weekly parade nights at our premises, arranging visits to various installations including airfields and Royal Air Force sites and taking part with other Squadrons at higher Wing level activities. Also cadets have the opportunity to attend annual camps and displays.
