The charity operates under a management committee consisting of the following officers:

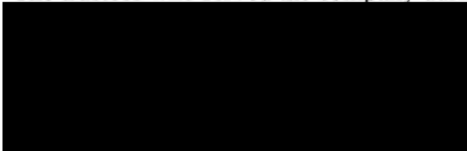

Blameless has been established to pursue the following objective:

- To advance education and raise awareness of the dangers of alcohol and drugs to disadvantaged children and young people within the community;
- To provide recreational activities to children and young people who have been affected by addiction and provide opportunities for them to engage in safe but fun activities to escape from the pressures of their lives;
- To provide an advisory and support service to those who are suffering from or affected in some way by addiction or are going through recovery in order to relieve their suffering and improve their lives and their families lives.
- Create healthy eating and healthy living hub in our communities

Significant Activities throughout the year

- Weekend Trips to retreats to help families with addiction issues bond
- Outings to a number of football matches
- Fundraisers including Fireworks event and Circus events serving over 5,000 in the community
- Excursions including fun days, circus, cinemas and pantomime trips
- Delivery of addiction talks to school and commerce including Astrazenica and Vodaphone
- Setting up foodbank, supplying gas and electricity top-up cards for families affected by addiction.
- Promoted better living, better health and better eating
- Budget Advisory Service and signposting families with trauma to professional help
- Distributed furniture, clothing and bedding in the community
- Engaging with the education system as well as politicians to offer lived experiences around the devastation addiction causes in our communities.

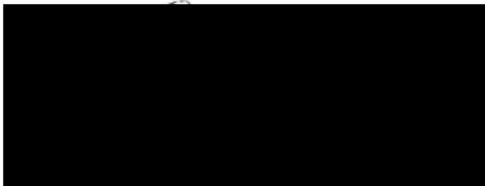
Basis Of Accounting

Independent Examiner's Report to the Trustees of Blameless SCIO
Year Ended 31 January 2025

I report on the accounts for the year ended 31 January 2025 set out on pages 4 and 5.

Respective responsibilities of trustees and examiner

The charity's trustees are responsible for the preparation of the accounts in accordance with the terms of the Charities and Trustee Investments (Scotland) Act 2005 and the Charities Accounts (Scotland) Regulations 2006. The charity's trustees consider that the audit requirement of Regulations 10 (1)(d) of the Accounts Regulations does not apply. It is my responsibility to examine the accounts as required under section 44(1)© of the Act and to state whether particular matters have come to my attention.


Basis of the independent examiner's report

My examination was carried out in accordance with Regulation 11 of the Charities Accounts (Scotland) Regulations 2006. An examination includes a review of the accounting records kept by the charity and a comparison of the accounts presented with those records. It also includes consideration of any unusual items or disclosures in the accounts and seeking explanations from you as the Trustees concerning any such matters. The procedures undertaken do not provide all the evidence that would be required in an audit, and consequently, I do not express an audit opinion on the view given by the accounts.

Independent examiner's statement

- I have completed my examination. I can confirm that no matters have come to my attention in connection with the examination giving me cause to believe that in any internal respect:

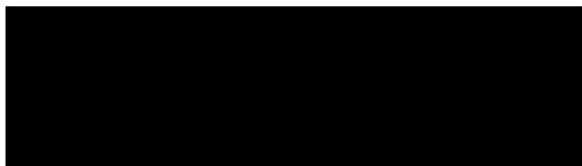
