## Activities

**Activities:** 'It carries out activities or services itself'

**Purposes:** 'the advancement of religion', 'the advancement of health', 'the relief of those in need by reason of age, ill-health, disability, financial hardship or other disadvantage'

**What the charity does:** 1) To advance the Christian Faith in accordance with the Licence Agreement executed with Ascension Trust (Scotland). 2) To advance health, including the prevention and relief of sickness and human suffering, including those suffering from, amongst other reasons, excessive alcohol or substance use or misuse. 3) To relieve those in need by reason of age, ill-health, disability, financial hardship or other disadvantage. These purposes are achieved particularly by means of caring, listening and helping people where appropriate. This would take the form of providing goods or services and the provision of counselling and general support. These aims are achieved by a team of at least 3 fully trained Street Pastors patrolling the streets and various venues in Kirkwall between the hours of 10pm on a Saturday night and 2am on a Sunday morning.

**Beneficiaries:** 'No specific group, or for the benefit of the community'

**Objectives:** 4.1 To advance the Christian Faith in accordance with the Licence Agreement executed with Ascension Trust (Scotland) and the Core Values and Mission Statement appearing in the Schedule hereto in Orkney and in such other parts of the United Kingdom or the world as the Trustees may from time to time to think fit, particularly but not exclusively by means of caring, listening and helping people on the streets and at various venues day and night. 4.2 To advance health, including the prevention and relief of sickness and human suffering, through the provision of goods or services of any kind including through the provision of counselling and support in Orkney and in such other parts of the United Kingdom or the world as the Trustees

may from time to time to think fit, particularly but not exclusively by means of caring, listening and helping people, including those suffering from amongst other reasons excessive alcohol or substance use or misuse, on the streets and at various venues, day and night. 4.3 To relieve those in need by reason of age, ill-health, disability, financial hardship or other disadvantage by the provision of goods or services of any kind including through the provision of counselling and support in Orkney and in such other parts of the United Kingdom or the world as the Trustees may from time to time to think fit, particularly but not exclusively by means of caring, listening and helping people on the streets and at various venues, day and night.
