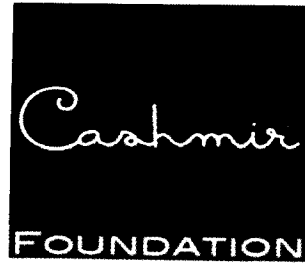

While 2024 presented many obstacles, it also reinforced the importance of adaptability and strategic focus. Some key areas of progress include:

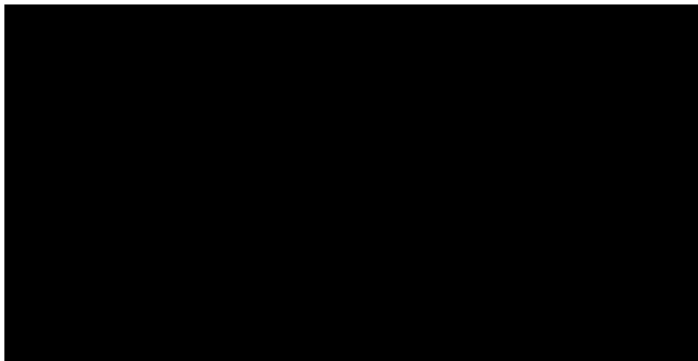
- Strengthening our digital infrastructure to improve outreach and communication.
