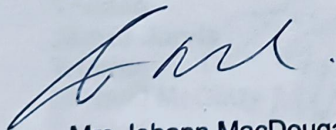

During the year the Group was working with restricted activities due to Covid 19. We are now back up and running and hoping to get back to full capacity

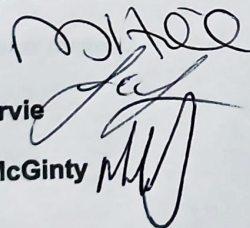
