What the charity does: Cockenzie House & Gardens was set up to bring Cockenzie House into community ownership. We have around 50 studios for artists, therapists and local small businesses, two self catering cottages, meeting spaces for local groups to meet, local families to celebrate and classes. We have a popular cafe and hold a series of markets and live music events. for the community, We organise events for the local community and our gardens are seen as a peaceful and relaxing space enjoyed by locals and visitors. Where a disused nursing home once stood, 900 people visit each week. One of the nation's last Jacobean mansion is being enjoyed and preserved.
