## **Independent Examiner's Report to the Trustees of The Weir Family Foundation**

I report on the accounts of the charity for the year ended 31 March 2025 which are set out on the attached pages.

### **Respective responsibilities of trustees and examiner**

The charity's trustees are responsible for the preparation of the accounts in accordance with the terms of the Charities and Trustee Investment (Scotland) Act 2005 and the Charities Accounts (Scotland) Regulations 2006. The charity trustees consider that the audit requirement of Regulation 10(1) (a) to (c) of the Accounts Regulations does not apply. It is my responsibility to examine the accounts as required under Section 44(1) (c) of the Act and to state whether particular matters have come to my attention.

### **Basis of Independent examiner's statement**

My examination is carried out in accordance with Regulation 11 of the Charities Accounts (Scotland) Regulations 2006. An examination includes a review of the accounting records kept by the charity and a comparison of the accounts presented with those records. It also includes consideration of any unusual items or disclosures in the accounts and seeks explanations from the trustees concerning any such matters. The procedures undertaken do not provide all the evidence that would be required in an audit, and consequently I do not express an audit opinion on the view given by the accounts.

### REPORT OF THE TRUSTEES

The Weir Family Foundation, 163 Bath Street, Glasgow, G2 4SQ is a registered charity, reference number SC044039. The Charity was registered as a Scottish Charity with OSCR on 29 May 2013.

The Charity's principal purposes are:

- The prevention or relief of poverty
- The advancement of education
- The advancement of health
- The advancement of public participation in sport
- The relief of those in need by reason of age, ill health, disability, financial hardship or other disadvantage
- The advancement of animal welfare

The Trustees are responsible for administering the affairs of the Charity, including the maintenance of its finances.

In connection with its responsibilities the Trustees are required to prepare accounts for each financial year which give a true and fair view of the state of affairs of the Charity and of the surplus or deficit of the Charity for that period. In preparing those accounts the Trustees are required to:

- Select suitable accounting policies and apply them consistently;
- Make estimates and judgments that are prudent;
- Prepare the accounts on the going concern basis unless it is inappropriate to presume that the Charity will continue in operational existence; and
- State whether applicable accounting standards have been followed, subject to any material departures disclosed and explained in the accounts.

The Trustees are responsible for keeping proper accounting records which disclose with reasonable accuracy at all times the financial position of the Charity and to enable them to ensure that the accounts comply with the Charities Accounts (Scotland) Regulations 2006 and the Statement of Recommended Practice for Charities. They are also responsible for the safeguarding of the assets of the Charity and hence taking reasonable steps for the prevention and detection of fraud and other irregularities.
