Trustee recruitment and appointment

The appointment of trustees is regulated in Section 12 of our constitution as follows:

“Charity Trusteeship is open to any individual aged 18 or over who has been nominated for membership by an existing trustee who subscribes to the purposes of the organisation and wishes to see them fulfilled. Any nominated individual who wishes to become a Charity Trustee must sign a written application for Charity Trusteeship. The application will then be considered by the Board at its next Board meeting.
The Board may, at its discretion, refuse to admit any nominated individual to Charity Trusteeship. The Board must notify each applicant promptly (in writing, which includes by e-mail) of its decision on whether or not to admit him/her to Charity Trusteeship.”

Objectives and activities


