of refugees, asylum seekers and other Immigrants, their families and dependents, (e) to promote, carry out and publish the useful results of research into (1) social conditions affecting children and other young people, prisoners, ex prisoners, offenders, ex offenders, those at risk of offending, persons affected by alcohol, drug and other addictions, refugees, asylum seekers and other immigrants and the families and dependents of such persons, and (2) the mental, psychological, spiritual, moral, social and physical needs of children and other young people, prisoners, ex prisoners, offenders, ex offenders, those at risk of offending, persons affected by alcohol, drug and other addictions, refugees, asylum seekers and other Immigrants and the families and dependents of such persons and to promote the education of the public and other organisations in relation to the same.
