What the charity does: We promote public participation in sport across the local communities, with a focus on football and other physically activities. also for those who have need of such facilities or would benefit from such activities by reason of their youth, age. Infirmary or disablement, financial hardship or social and economic circumstances. 3.5 To advance education in the community in Scotland, particularly in relation to health and fitness, sporting activity and life skills. through providing or organising educational, training and lifelong learning opportunities.
