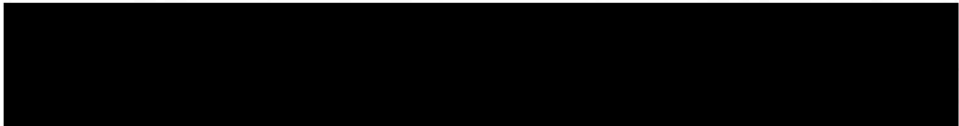

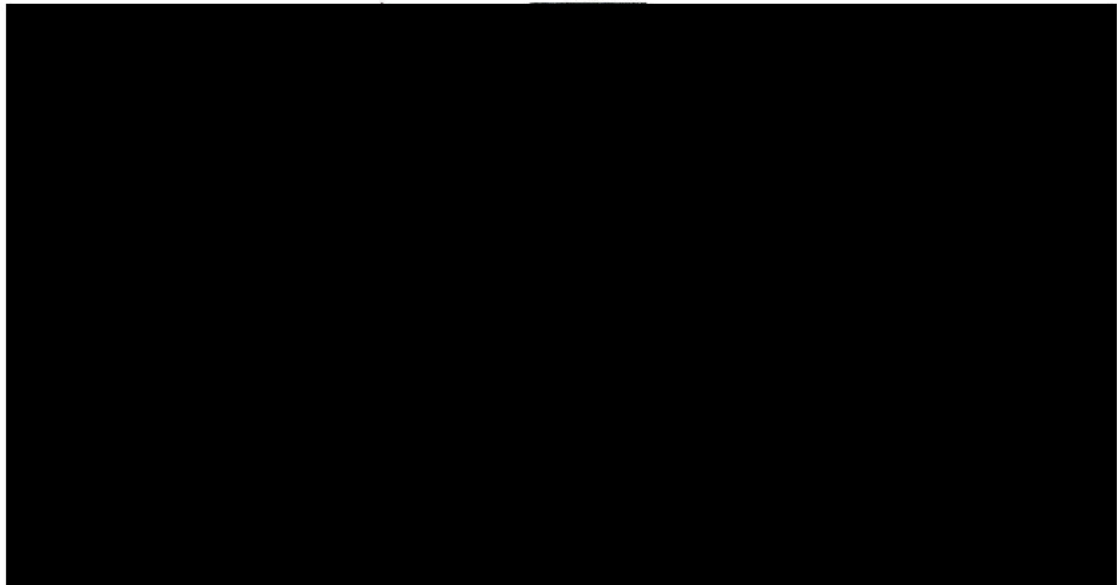

Independent examiner's statement
