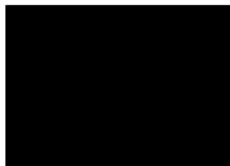

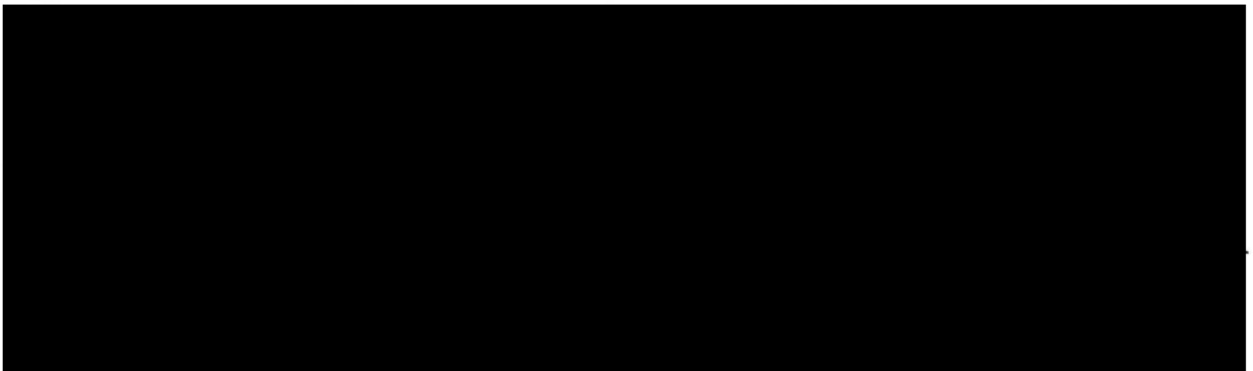

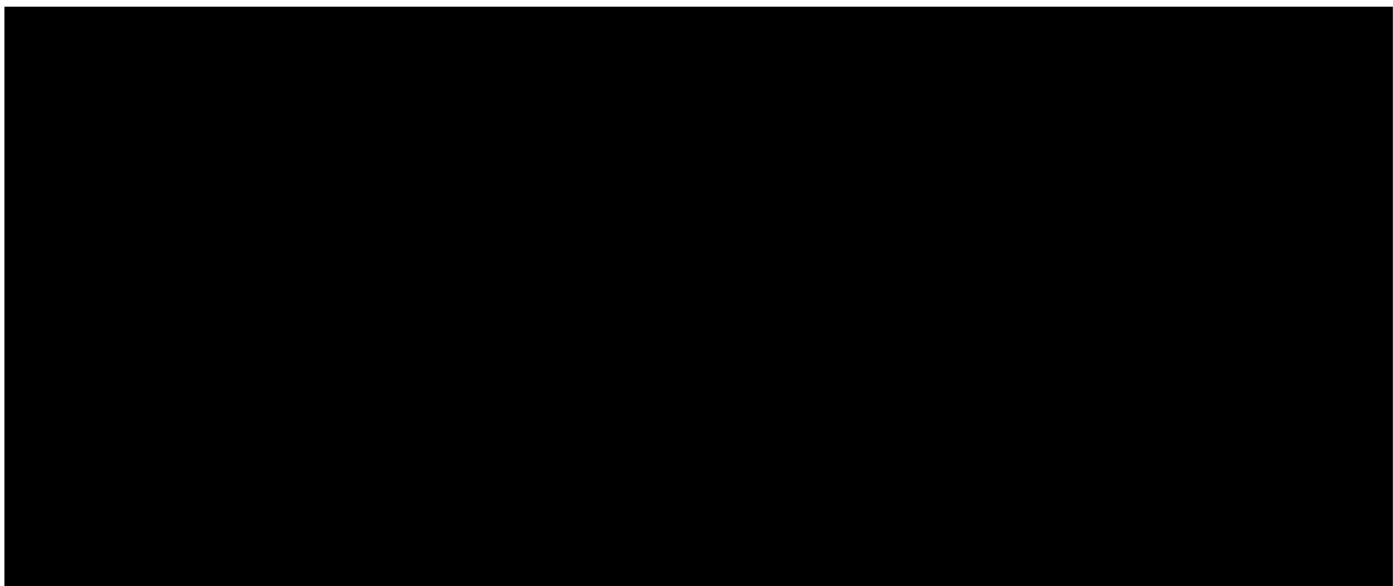

**INDEPENDENT EXAMINER'S REPORT TO THE TRUSTEES OF LARGS
EVENTS SCIO**

I report on the accounts of the charity for the year ended 31 December 2024.

Respective responsibilities of the Trustees and examiner

The charity's trustees are responsible for the preparation of the accounts in accordance with the terms of the charities and Trustee Investment (Scotland) Act 2005 and the Charities Accounts (Scotland) Regulations 2006. The charity trustees consider that the audit requirement of Regulation 10 (1) (d) of the Accounts Regulations does not apply. Basis of independent examiner's statement

My examination is carried out in accordance with Regulation 11 of the Charities Accounts (Scotland) Regulations 2006. It also includes consideration of any unusual items or disclosures in the accounts, and seeks explanations from the trustees concerning any such matters. The procedures undertaken do not provide all the evidence that would be required in an audit, and consequently I do not express an audit opinion on the view given by the accounts.


Independent examiner's statement
