Objectives

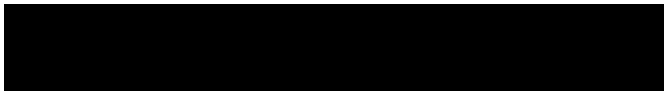
The objectives of the charity are:

Main Activities of Buddy's Field SCIO during the Financial Year

During the initial period all activities ceased due to lockdown restrictions. Since easing of restrictions, range and frequency of activities remains affected however every attempt has been made to deliver on Buddy's Field objectives.

- Children negatively impacted by school closures were educationally and emotionally supported first remotely and then within individual 'bubble' sessions.
- These sessions last approximately three hours and a 'whole child' approach adopted.
- In addition to Language and Maths support, activities included:

Establishing, planting and harvesting a garden.

Cooking and compiling recipes in a Lockdown Recipe Book.

Exploration walks.

Craft activities.

Adult sewing and craft awaits the reopening of premises.

Contact has been maintained with beneficiaries and all are eager to return. If StBridgets remains closed for the foreseeable future, other venue options will be explored.

Responsibilities of the Trustees

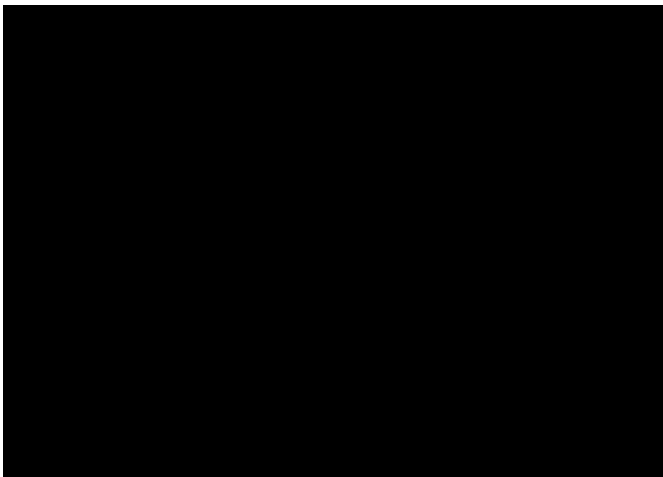
