Summary of the main activities in relation to these objects

a. GMA has continued to campaign for minorities online and has raised awareness for minority issues through events like ceilidhs and concerts, and through report writing.
b. In December 2016, partnership with BooksAbroad SC011359, GMA has shipped school books to Kibera, Kenya which arrived in Spring 2017. GMA also released funds for the purchase of furniture for the new library.
c. Through the Thailand report, GMA has identified areas of need for providing care for refugees in Thailand. Through awareness raising GMA hopes to raise funds to provide facilities.



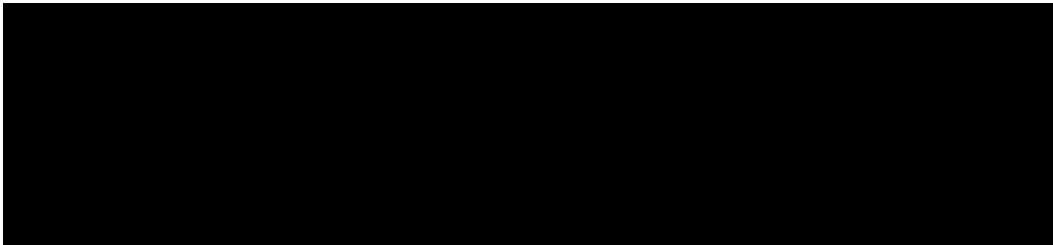
