My examination is carried out in accordance with Regulation 11 of the Charities Accounts (Scotland)

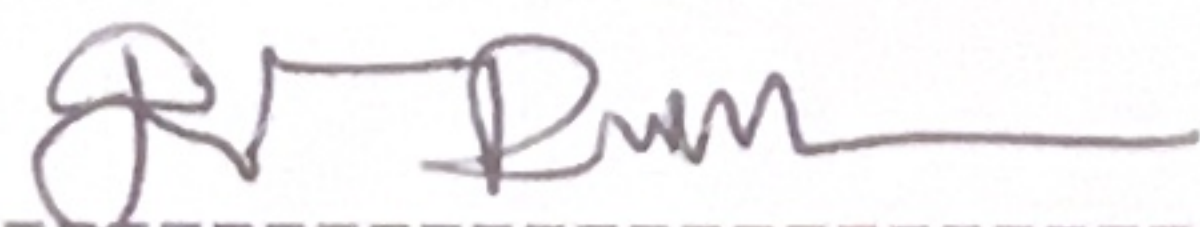
